ROSY: They are lovely! I knew everything would be all right.


Rex sold the shoes and bought some leather and food with the money.

One night, Rex and Rosy saw five elves come into their house, dancing




The elves finished their work and went away.

to have enough to eat!




ROSY: Such kind, helpful little people! I will make some clothes for them just to say 'thank you'.

The Ant and the Sparrow




The ant did not know how to swim. He began to drown. He tried to keep his head above the water.





Hasan went crying to the Qazi and told him what had happened. The Qazi said Hasan had not said clearly what he was selling. So he would have to give away his donkey to the barber.


Hasan decided to teach the barber a lesson. One day, he dressed up like a rich man and went to the barber's shop.

He sat down on the grass and began




to paint the flowers. He painted the roses red and the daffodils bright yellow.




