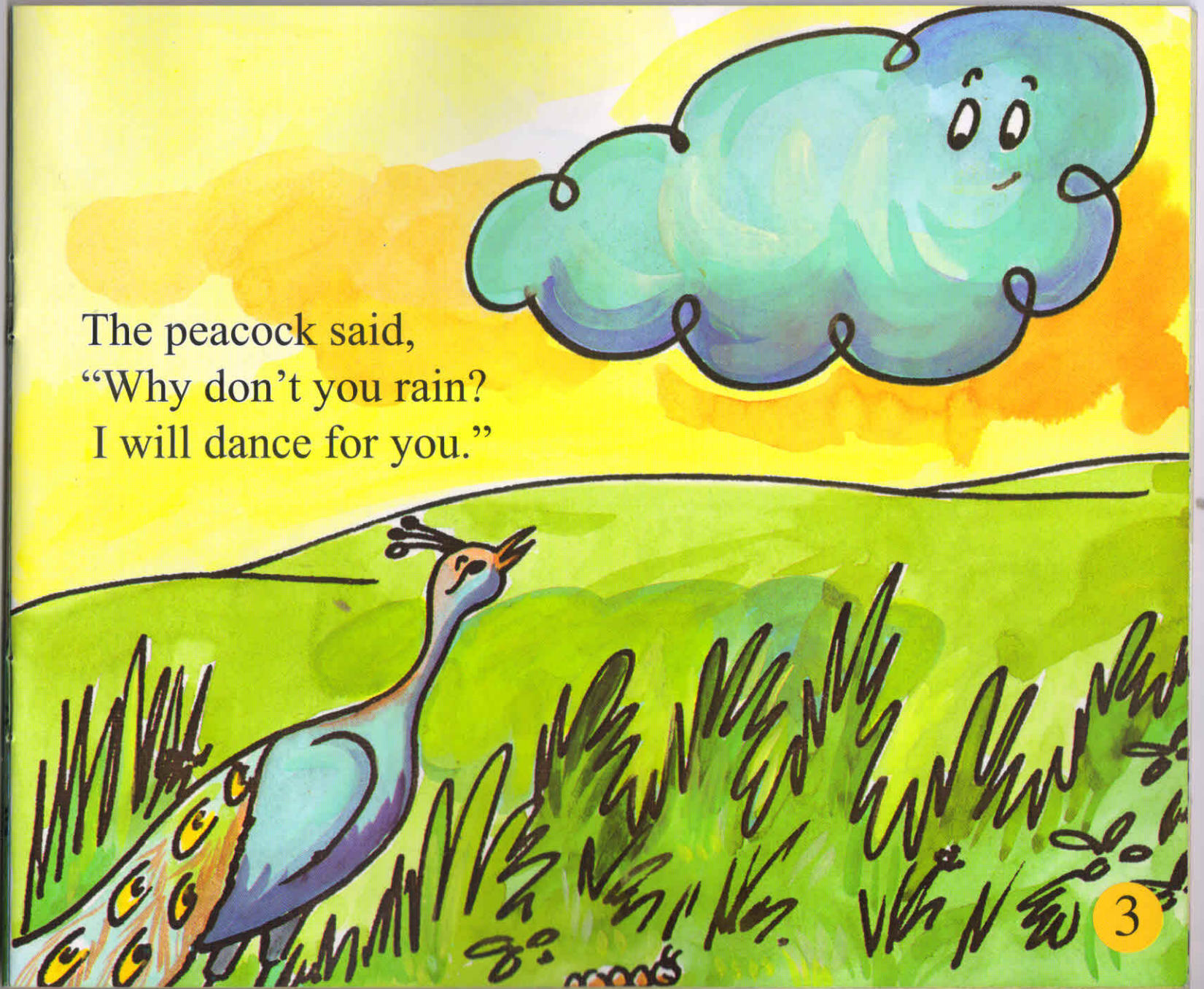


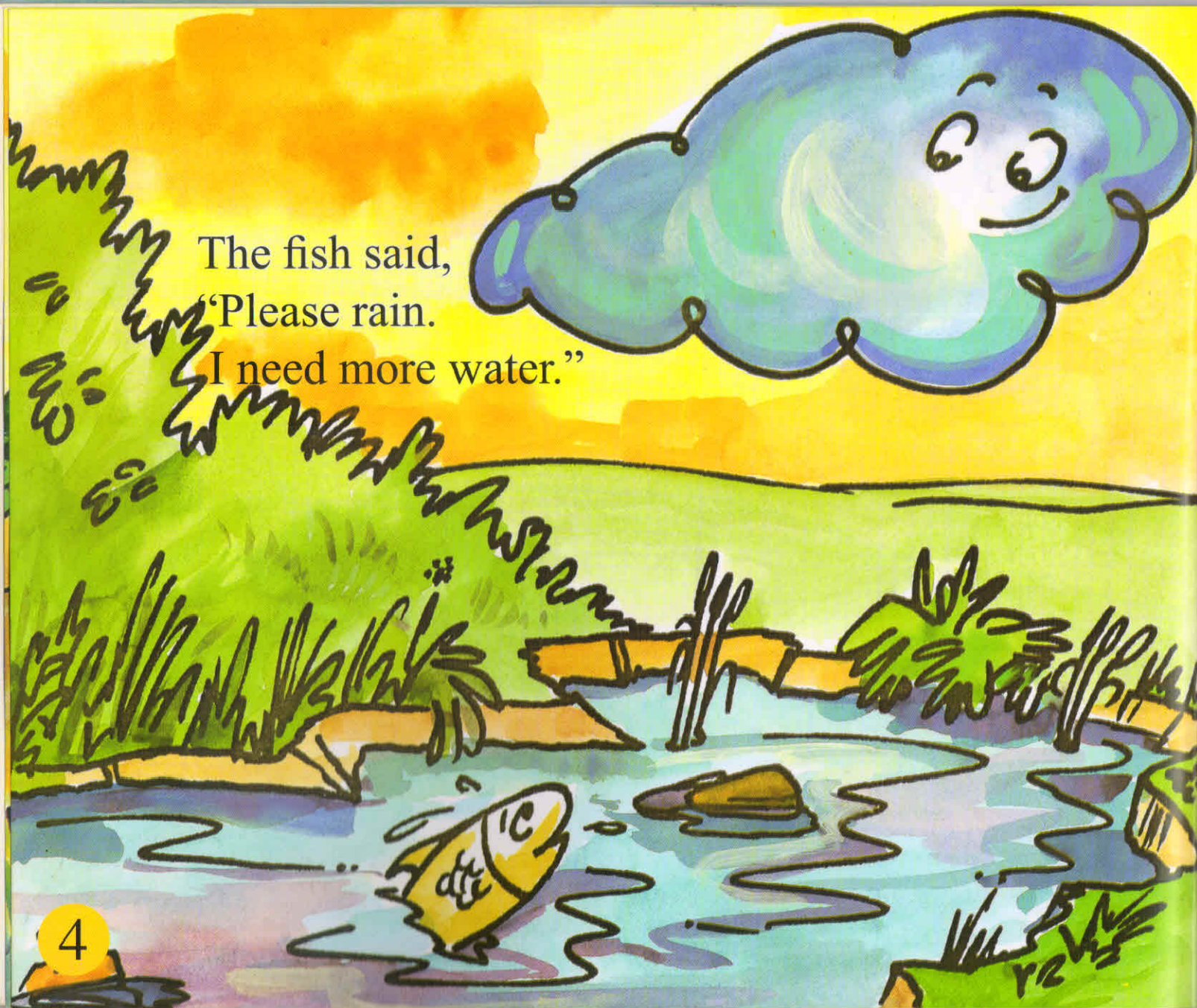


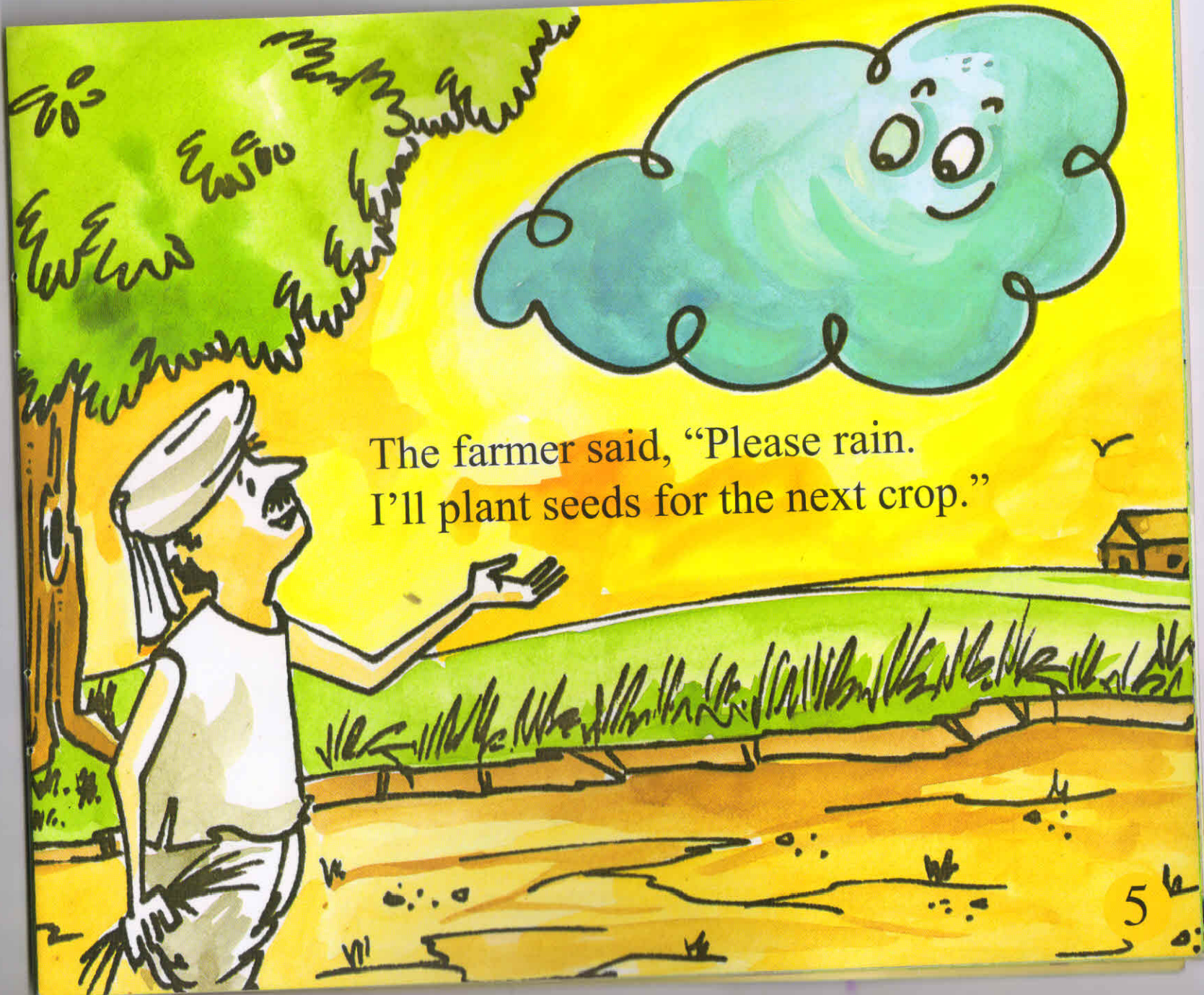
A cloud rolled along
merrily in the sky.




The peacock said,

I'll plant seeds for the next crop."

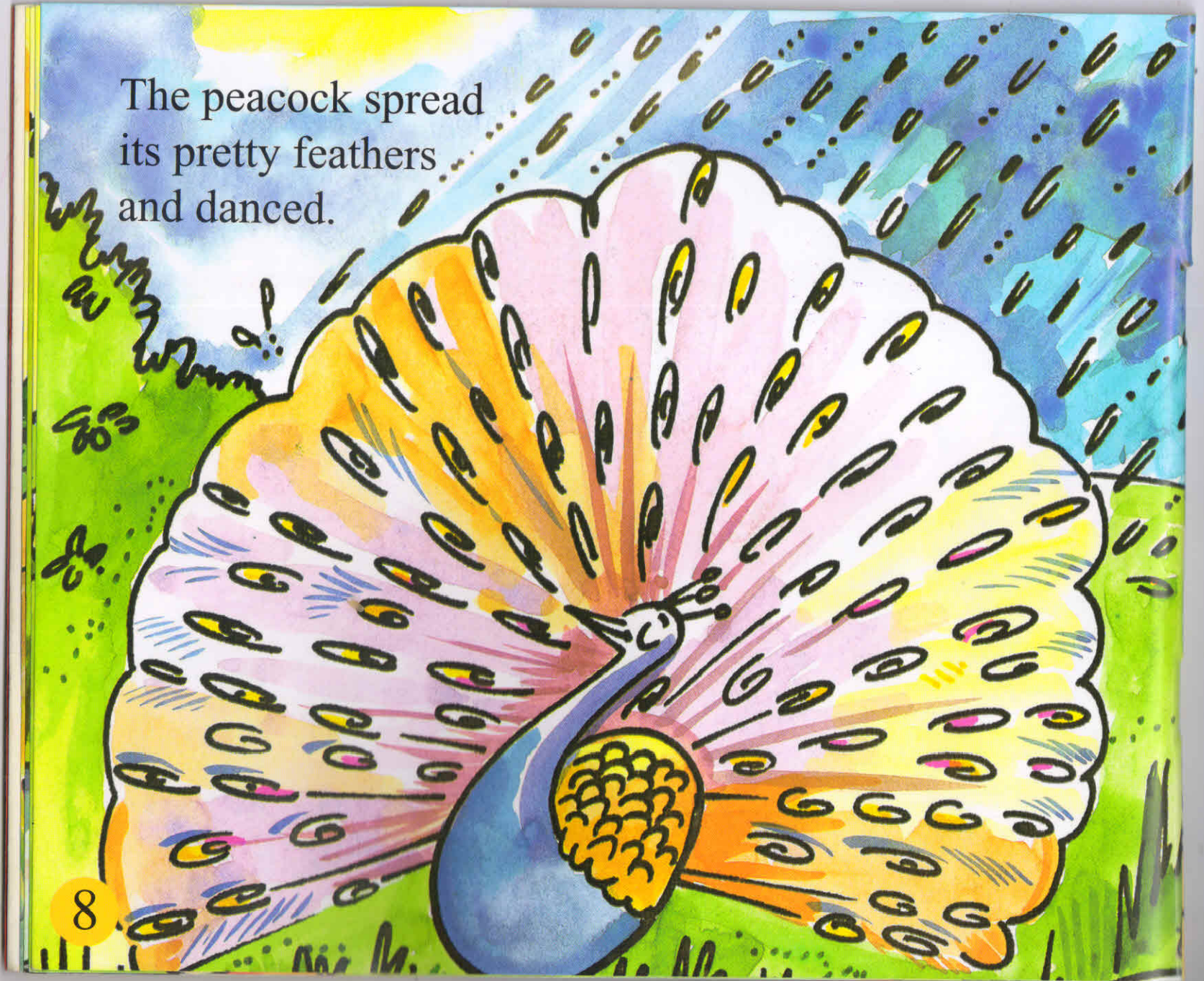


Raju said, "If you rain,
